COMMITTEE'S REPORT.

To the Life Governors, Annual Governors and Contributors.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN,—

Your Committee have pleasure in submitting for your approval their 76th Annual Report.

FINANCE.

With the ever expanding needs of a Base Hospital, which is constantly meeting largely increased demands upon its services, the matter of finance is one which calls for very serious consideration. During the year under review, the gross expenditure for maintenance was £7740/10/10 being an increase of £1,333 over the previous year. This advance in expenditure was occasioned by the very large increase in the number of patients and the necessary augmenting of Staff. The response from both the city and country has been such, that, despite the increased expenditure, the year closed with a credit of £272 which is highly satisfactory. Although the appeals to the public are for larger and larger amounts each year, in order to meet the greater expenditure, it is encouraging to know that the annual cost per bed is still very low in comparison with other country Hospitals. For the previous year the figure was £107, and this year the cost is lower still being £101, which is one of the lowest in the State and lower than any other Country Base Hospital in Victoria. These figures are particularly interesting as they prove conclusively that the administration is on the most strict economical lines consistent with efficiency.

PATIENTS.

During the year 644 males and 660 females, a total of 1304 in-patients were treated, being an increase of 380 over last year. The Infectious Diseases Hospital has been open for the greater part of the year and 39 males and 37 females, a total of 76 have been treated. The Daily Average has also increased considerably being 76.616. The Maternity Ward, which is amongst the recent additions to the Hospital, continues to prove its usefulness. During the past year 106 babies were born in the Hospital.

HONORARY MEDICAL STAFF.

Special thanks are accorded to Doctors I. H. Henderson, H. I. Holmes, F. E. Littlewood, J. F. Patrick, A. E. Brauer, and Irving Buzzard. Doctor F. E. Littlewood was granted leave of absence to enable him to visit England for special studies, after which he returned to his Honorary position on the Staff. Dr. William Loftus, who acted to L. T. for Dr. Littlewood, resigned from the Honorary Medical Staff on leaving for Kattanning, W.A.

RESIDENT MEDICAL OFFICER.

Dr. E. J. Day completed a term of 6 months as R. M. O. and Dr. J. F. Drew temporarily filled the position. Unfortunately the position is still vacant owing to the scarcity of junior medical men. It is hoped, however, that the position will be filled in about a month's time. Further special thanks are accorded to the honorary medical staff, who have so willingly given so much extra time and service during the vacancy.

NURSING STAFF.

Sister F. T. Hance resigned her position as night sister and Sister G. H. Brooks was appointed to the position. Sister V. W. Skinner was appointed in her stead. During the year Sister E. Carroll was appointed to the maternity ward, but decided to relinquish the position, which, at the time of writing, is vacant. Nurses A. Skilbeck, K. M. Gleeson and A. E. Giroud have been successful in passing their R.N.T.N.A. Examination and have received certificates accordingly.

RETIRING OFFICERS.

Messrs. J. Dickson and Dr. Henderson, city members of Committee retire by effluxion of time and are eligible for re-election. Mr. A. G. Stevens, city member, and Mr. G. Campbell, country member, have resigned owing to their having left the district, and are thanked for their services to the Hospital. Messrs. D. O'Keefe and W. A. Anderson retire by effluxion of time and are eligible for re-election.

RED CROSS HOSPITAL AUXILIARIES.

The Committee extend their hearty and appreciative thanks to the members of the City Auxiliary, Allansford, Dennington, Allan's Forest, Wangoom, Grasmere, Woodford, Nullawarre, and other centres for their valuable and helpful interest and contributions which are so willingly given to the Hospital on behalf of the sick and suffering. The work of the ladies from the City Auxiliary who attend at the Hospital weekly for sewing is also greatly appreciated.

During the year the usual Jam Day was held in the City, Allansford Auxiliary also held a Jam Day at a latter date, both these efforts were highly successful and the net result to the Hospital was about 790 jars of jam. This is a considerable increase on the previous year's contribution, and, while possibly insufficient for the year's supply, will go a long way towards meeting the demand. All those who helped or contributed are cordially thanked.

Another valuable institution is the annual Egg Day. This year all previous records were broken and nearly 2,000 dozen eggs were received. These will just about meet the needs of the Hospital until next Egg Day. The thanks of the Committee are gratefully given to all who contributed, not forgetting the scholars of the various schools concerned. Thanks are also given to Saltau and Son Pty. Ltd. and Mr. W. J. Murfett for free carriage, and also to Mr. H. H. Smith for again supervising testing, and putting down the large number of eggs received.

The auxiliary movement continues to be of inestimable value both in the metropolitan area and country districts. A special feature of the local branches is that each auxiliary is concentrating on meeting one particular need, e.g. the City auxiliary aims at supplying the Hospital with linen, Dennington auxiliary with crockery. Allansford auxiliary, cutlery, while several contribute extras such as biscuits, jellies; preserved fruits, etc. Such organised efforts are of immense value to the Hospital.

WOOD DAY.

The local branch of Toc H. has taken up the matter of the supply of firewood for the hospital with the result that the whole of the firewood required for the coming year is assured. A representative committee was formed, and with the offer of Mr. P. R. Le Couteur of the wood on his property, many bands of volunteers gave their time and services and cut and stacked nearly 400 tons of wood, which will be delivered at the Hospital during the summer months. It is impossible to mention the names of all who have helped, including the ladies who provided refreshments for the workers, but to all who helped or gave, and to Mr. R. M. Burnie, chairman of committee, and Mr. J. Fletcher Jones, who is organising the effort on behalf of Toc H., the thanks of the Committee are freely given. Needless to add, this contribution of firewood will be a welcome relief to the funds of the Hospital.

HOSPITAL "DRIVE"

One of the outstanding features of the year was the Hospital "Drive" on the 29th May last, which was an unqualified success. The central idea of the "Drive" was to make it a concentrated and combined effort whereby everyone in the community would have equal opportunity of making an annual contribution to the funds of the Hospital. It was hoped that the country districts would co-operate with the city and thus have one big day in common for the Hospital. This was realised to a considerable extent, and it is expected that when the effort is made next year all the country districts

will come into line. In addition to the large number of willing and enthusiastic collectors in the country some 44 volunteer collectors gave up their time to collect in the city, and the grateful thanks of the Committee are accorded to these gentlemen for their splendid work. Although the "Drive" will probably be made somewhat earlier in the coming year, it is particularly to be noted that the appeal is only one Annual Appeal. The net result of the effort was £732 from the city, and £769 from the country, making a total of £1501 for the "Drive."

EMPLOYEE'S CONTRIBUTIONS.

The "Drive" does not in any way interfere with the very considerable regular income which is being received from the systematic contributions of the Employees of public bodies and private firms, and the grateful thanks of the Committee are given to all those who so help to swell the funds of the Institution. ENTERTAINMENTS.

The outstanding event of the year was the C.T.A. Carnival and Ball. A large number of Commercial Travellers were present and gave themselves whole-heartedly to ensure the success of the effort. They were helped by Mesdames Anderson and Bartlett supported by a strong local committee. The net result was £273/7/6 of which £200 was applied to the reduction of the Building Debt and the balance to Maintenance. The best thanks of the Committee are given to those concerned.

The Warrnambool Racing Club held the usual Charity Meeting for the Hospital, and as a result the sum of £143/1/- was thankfully received. Several entertainments, dances, etc. have been held in the city and country for the benefit of the Hospital, and to all those who organised these efforts, or otherwise contributed to their success, the Committee tender their best thanks.

TENNIS COURT.

This very necessary adjunct for the recreation of the nursing staff is now almost an accomplished fact. Through the efforts of Mr. Hugh Brown the funds increased sufficiently to have the court laid down, and all that is now required is sufficient to complete the fencing. The initial work of levelling and preparing the site was kindly done by Mr. B. L. Taylor and his volunteers, who are still available for further work.

WIRELESS INSTALLATION.

This part of the Hospital equipment continues to function well, and it is impossible to even estimate the value of such a plant to the patients. Mr. H. H. Hill is thanked for his kind attention to the set.

COUNTRY DISTRICT QUOTAS.

The organised effort in the Country Districts, whereby each separate centre provides a certain amount as its Quota each year, continues to yield excellent results. While, in some instances, the collections were incomplete when the books closed, it is gratifying to record that, owing to the appeal for additional help, some of the Districts made extra donations, viz.—Purnim, Allansford, Dennington, Winslow, Nullawarre and Yangery.

BUILDING FUND.

The overdraft on account of the Building Fund was £4,029/18/- at the beginning of the year. The amount now owing to the Bank is £1,239/16/7. While this is a considerable reduction, the Committee is anxious to reduce it still further, on account of the heavy item of interest involved. During the year the following amounts have been received, viz:—Government Grant, £2,000; from the C.T.A. Appeal, £200; from the Whicher Estate, £144/4/2; and from the Trustees of the Thomas Burden, £775/10/10.

GENERAL.

To the Press for their most valuable help in advocating the claims of the Hospital, especially for the wide publicity given in preparation for the "Drive," as well as all those who, either anonymously or otherwise, and whether by service or financial contribution, have helped the Hospital in any way, the Committee tender their appreciative thanks.

The House Committee, which was appointed last year under new conditions, has met weekly. This arrangement has proved its usefulness and is of great value to the Hospital. Under the guidance of this Committee many improvements have been made about the buildings and grounds.

OBITUARY.

During the year the Hospital suffered a heavy loss through the death of Mr. Wm. Swinton. Mr. Swinton had been a valued member of the Committee for very many years, and was also a past President. He was also a member of several sub-committees, and was at all times untiring in his interest and efforts for the Hospital. The Committee record their debt of gratitude for his ever willing services, and also their sincere sympathy with his widow.

The Rev. Mons Marshall also passed away during the year. He was ever a staunch friend of the Hospital, and, during his sojourn in Warrnambool, not only advocated its claims, but himself consistently supported it. His bequest is acknowledged elsewhere with grateful remembrance of his life and work.

Another link with the earlier work of the Hospital was broken with the passing away of Dr. Thomas Fleetwood. Dr. Fleetwood was one of the pioneer Medical Officers of the Hospital and for over 40 years gave of his best to the Hospital. The Committee remember his services with grateful appreciation and tender their sympathy with his widow.
